

Boarding Check List

- Please have your vaccinations records faxed or e-mailed to us **before your check-in date** so we can reach your vet in case we need clarification on a vaccination. You will need proof of Rabies, Distemper and Bordetella (kennel cough). Bordetella, if administered orally or nasally, has a five (5) day wait period before your pet can board. If administered by injection there is a fourteen (14) day wait period. We also strongly recommend, **but not required**, that you have the H2N8 and H3N2 canine influenza vaccinations. You should discuss these two influenza vaccinations with your vet.
- Please **fully complete** your boarding paperwork that was provided by Woof & Whiskers. The information we seek is important for us to have and there is a reason for each question. If possible, please provide your completed paperwork **in advance** via fax or e-mail to speed up your check-in. If you are unable to do so you may complete the paperwork in our lobby but please plan to spend an additional 10-15 minutes at check-in.
- Please bring dry food in either pre-packed in zip lock bags for individual servings or in a container (size for amount of food needed) or large zip bag(s) with the amount of food for your pet's entire stay. We recommend you pack an extra serving or two in case your pick up date is extended. Please do not bring large bags of food as we have limited space and they are heavy for staff to lift. If your pet eats wet food, please bring enough cans/packages for your visit.
- You may bring your pet's treats and any required medication your pet is currently taking – please note there is a \$1 charge per administration for medication. Please provide any medication in the container it came in listing the type of medication, dose instructions and vet's information that prescribed it.
- You may bring toys (maximum of 3 please)
- **All dogs must enter the facility on a leash.** This is for everyone's safety. Please provide a release type collar or harness for quick easy removal verses a buckle type. If your dog uses a prong or steel choke collar please bring a release collar or harness regardless. We can loan one if necessary.
- We provide the bedding and the food bowls. We have raised bowls, slow feeder bowls, etc. so **please do not bring your pet's bowls.** We also have a variety of bedding to make your pet comfortable. You may bring a t-shirt or small blanket with scent from home. Please do not bring a large pet bed that cannot fit in a washing machine. If it becomes soiled and we cannot wash the bedding it will pose a health hazard.
